

<b>2016 School Election Calendar</b> The annual election for school districts shall be held between the second Tuesday in April and the third Tuesday in June (SDCL <u>13-7-10</u> ). The days to the right are found to be the most common. A school district may choose an alternative date. School districts with a total enrollment of **more than 2,000 students**, within 15 days of filing a nominating petition, a <u>candidate</u> must file a Candidate Financial Interest Statement (<u>12-25-30</u>). This is filed with the person in charge of the election and a sample form can be found at sdsos.gov, under Elections & Voting, Campaign Finance and Paper forms.

**Note:** If the school election is combined with a municipal election on a date other than the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday in April, all dates follow <u>SDCL 13-7</u> (except when combined with the county for a primary election).

<u>Ballot color for combined elections:</u> if combining, one ballot must be white and the other jurisdiction will use a contrasting color (do not use yellow as that is the color for sample ballots). <u>ARSD 05:02:06:18</u>

**Notify County Auditor:** Contact your County Auditor when you know you will have an election and ask if he/she can be available from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on that date to answer questions regarding voter registration. (SDCL 7-7-2)
