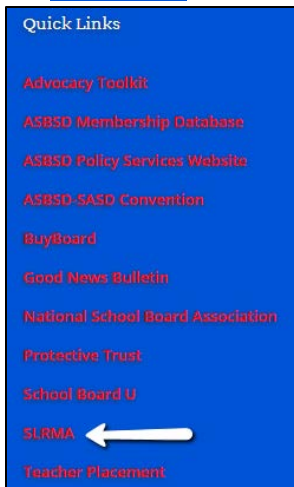


SLRMA Website Navigation Guide

Accessing and logging in to SLRMA website

1. To access the SLRMA website, visit <http://www.slrma.org/> or go to <http://asbsd.org/> and click the [SLRMA link](#) located at the bottom of the webpage under the Quick Links header:

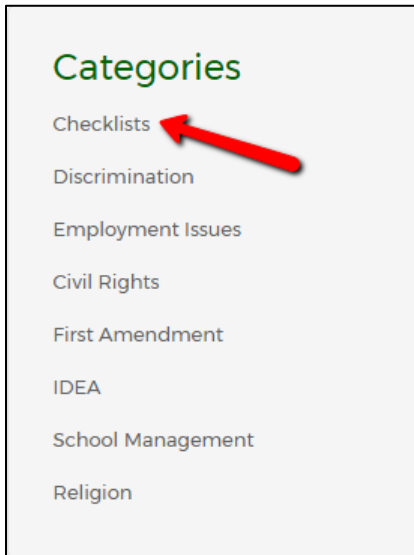


2. On the SLRMA website's homepage, enter your login and password in the Member Login fields and click the blue Log In button:

Navigating the SLRMA website

- After logging in, you will be taken to SLRMA's newsroom page, which is the hub to reach the valuable information available on the website:

- On the Newsroom page you can scroll through the variety of topics and resources SLRMA has covered, review and click on the most recent subjects they've covered in the Recently Added box located on the left side of the page, explore and view the most popular matters in the Trending column located on the right side of page and sift through the multitude of issues SLRMA delves into in the Categories collection found at the top left of the page.
- To review the many different Checklists put together by SLRMA click the Checklists link found in the Categories box:

U.S. Department of Education Changes Course on Title IX Responsibilities for Sexual Misconduct

On September 22, 2017, the U.S. Department of Education Office for Civil Rights issued a Dear Colleague Letter withdrawing the statements of policy and guidance reflected in two key documents about Title IX and sexual violence issued under the Obama administration: the Dear Colleague Letter on Sexual Violence dated April 4, 2011, and the Questions and Answers on Title IX and Sexual Violence, dated April 29, 2014. This discussion summarizes the policy change and explains the implications for school districts.

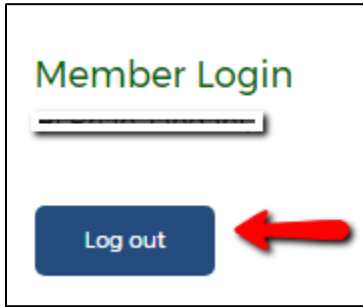
