ASBSD has recently updated 10 sample policies which cover a wide swath of subject areas.

The sample policies can be reviewed at <a href="http://policy.asbsd.org">http://policy.asbsd.org</a>. Here is a summary of the updates:

**BD School Board Meetings**: revision to complete the reference in state law.

**BDC Executive Sessions**: updated to align with state law on executive session.

**BDDE Parliamentary Procedure**: minor word changes.

**CBA Superintendent Job Description**: revised to reflect that the district's Superintendent reports to the Board of Education.

**GCPC Retirement of Professional Staff Members**: non-substantive style edits, and updates to legal references.



**IIBFA Use of Artificial Intelligence Technology**: removes references to specific AI technology tools and simple word changes.

JFA Student Due Process Rights: correction in spelling errors.

JFC Student Conduct: revised to include the crime of juvenile sexting and other updated references.

JFCD Bullying: adds the reference to the crime of juvenile sexting.

**JFCH Alcohol And Other Drug Use By Students**: removes reference that identified tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaping devices as in the same category as alcohol and drug use to address a conflict with Policy AEA Tobacco And Vaping Free Schools.
